BUS CODE OF CONDUCT

Everyone has the right to travel without being abused or intimidated in any way

Pupils have responsibility for:

- ✓ Ensuring their bus pass is with them at all times
- ✓ Organising a replacement should they lose their bus pass
- ✓ Queuing up and boarding the bus sensibly
- ✓ Once on the bus, finding a seat and sitting down quickly
- ✓ Wearing a seat belt when one is available
- ✓ Not attempting to distract the bus driver
- ✓ Remaining seated whilst the bus is travelling
- ✓ Being respectful to each other, the bus driver and fellow passengers
- ✓ Chatting quietly with others near by
- ✓ Not using bad language
- ✓ NOT leaning out of the windows
- ✓ Being respectful to the driver and bus property

Parents/Carers have responsibility for:

- ✓ Ensuring pupils are fully aware of and understand their responsibilities.
- ✓ Making sure pupils have a bus pass
- ✓ Reminding pupils of the importance of wearing a seatbelt when one is available
- ✓ Supporting Swanmore College with complaints regarding poor behaviour on the buses. The College will deal with any complaints in the same way as poor behaviour whilst at the College.

Poor behaviour whilst travelling to and from the College could result in:-

- ✓ Pupils receiving a verbal warning
- ✓ Pupils receiving a written warning
- ✓ Pupils being temporarily excluded from travelling on the bus
- ✓ Pupils being permanently excluded from travelling on the bus
